

Accessing MATLAB at Texas A&M University

As of January 16, 2023, the version of MATLAB running on Texas A&M Open Access accounts is 9.13.0.2126072 (Release 2022b). You can check the release you have by typing *ver* at the MATLAB prompt. MATLAB 9.13, Release 2022b, was released on September 15, 2022; the MathWorks company typically releases a new version each spring (Release a) and a new version each fall (Release b).
