Create your account by going to <https://ttd.ph.utexas.edu/createAccount.html>. Note that account names must consist of letters and digits -- no other characters are allowed. No spaces, periods, underscores, commas -- just letters and digits. Your account name "m-tribble" does not follow this rule. Please press the "Back" button and try again.

- If you have an account already (from a different class or a previous semester), use it, and leave this page now.
- Write the account name and password down before you type them into the boxes below.

Be sure your computer clock is correct. The due time of 11P is enforced by the server using the server's clock. So, check your watch or clock against the server's clock when you click B.1 as the time is shown near the top of the page. Or, use option A.5.

Click "get questions" and print the pdf file. Logout of the system by using the "RETURN TO MENU" button in the upper right corner.

Work the questions on the printout until you are sure of your answers.

You will have only one try when submitting your answers.

Log back into the system after working the questions. Again you will need to choose your class and choose the B1 option to do academic work. This time, choose the option to "submit work" and you will be sent to a answer sheet page. [Note the screenshot is from the Fall 2006 semester].
